## "Sex-Specific Differences in Chronic Kidney Disease"

Chronic kidney disease (CKD) is among the fastest growing non-communicable diseases and represents a major burden for health systems worldwide. CKD is more prevalent in women, yet men have been shown to be advantaged or over-represented in disease awareness, diagnose and treatment. If the root causes of many observed sex-disparities are of biological nature or driven by socio-economic factors is often unclear. In this Science Lunch, Sebastian Hödlmoser will give an overview about current discussions around sex-specific differences in CKD and present his own research about the topic.
