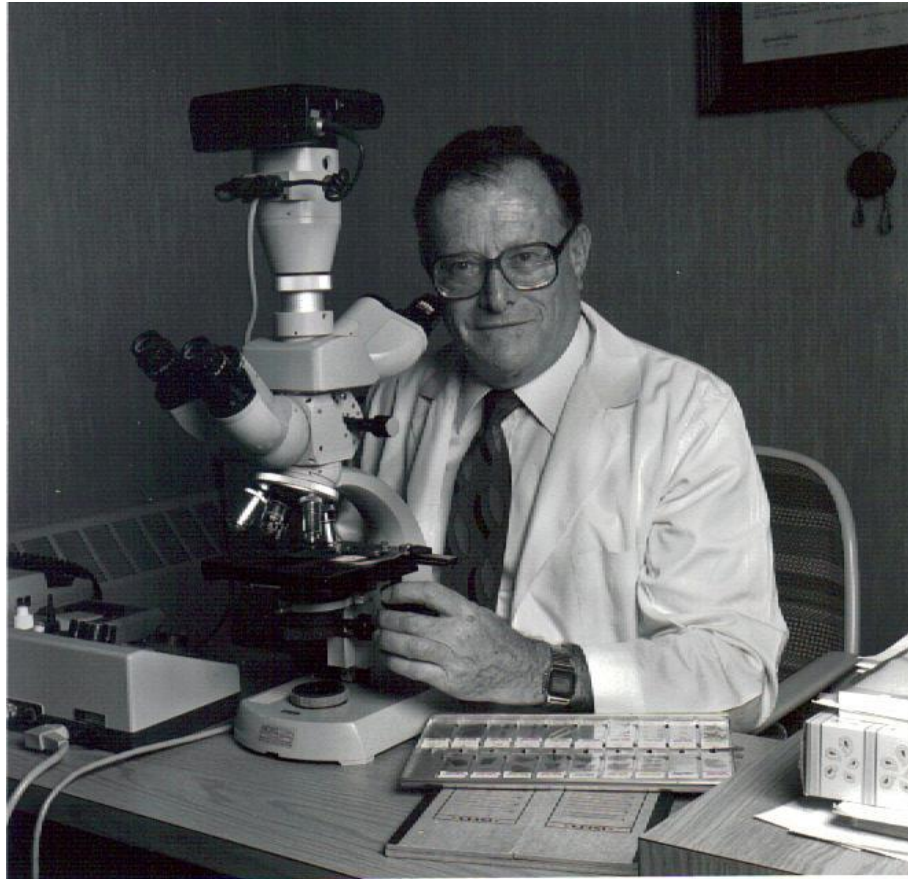

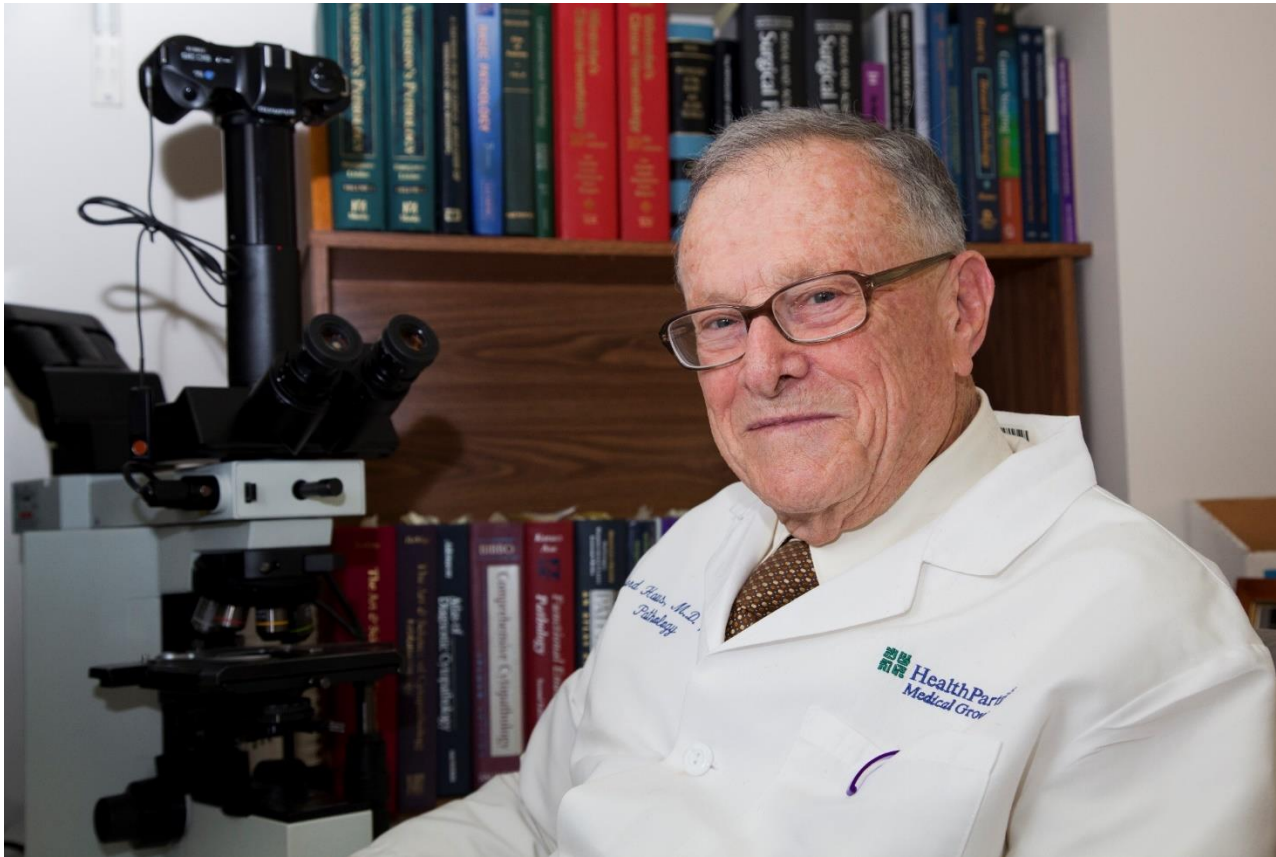

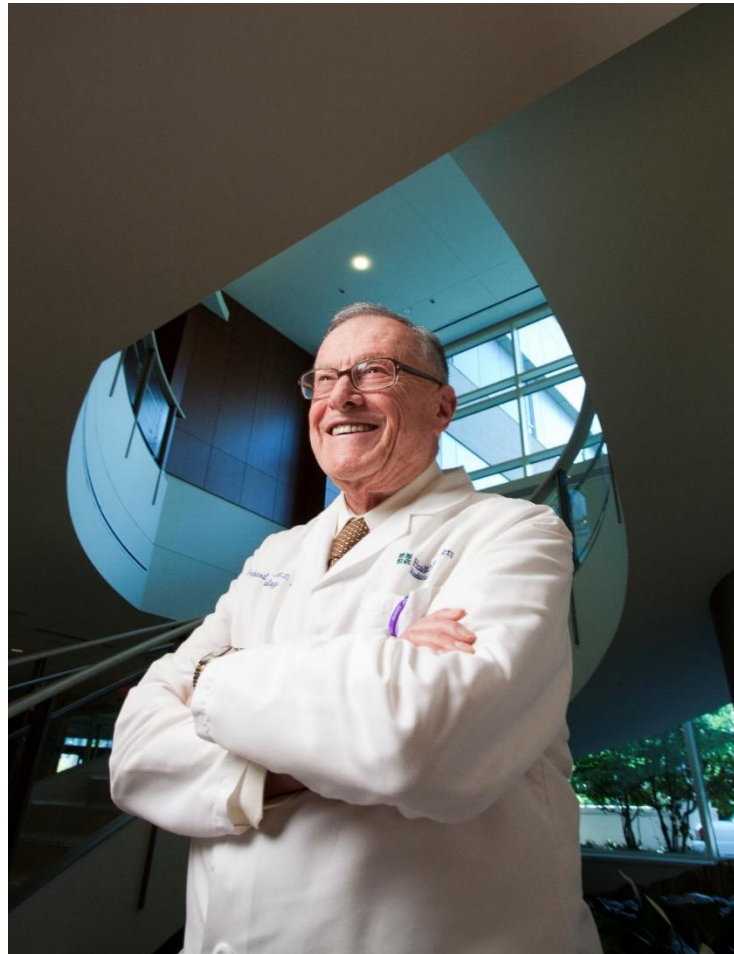


TWO GREAT PIONEERS

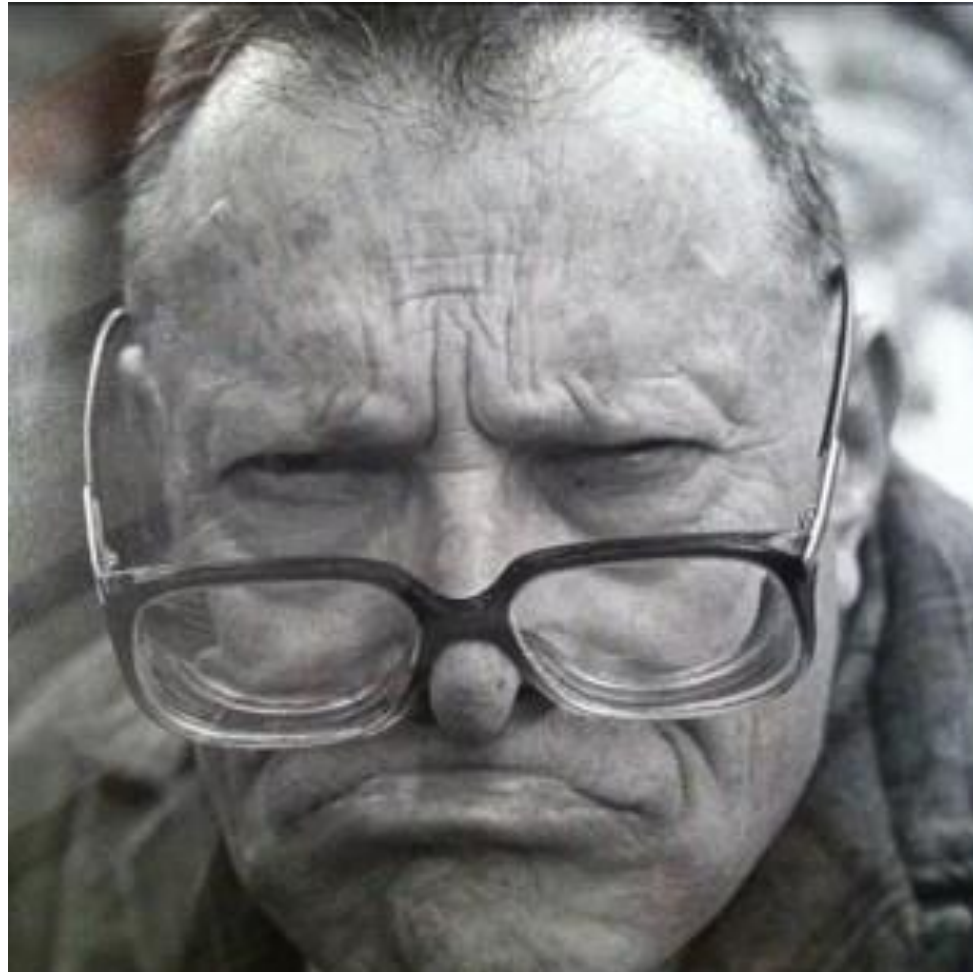


Family photo
